PLAINTIFF'S OPPOSITION TO DEFENDANT'S
MOTION TO COMPEL ARBITRATION
STAY PROCEEDINGS PENDING ARIBTRATION AND REPLY THERETO

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, comes Plaintiff, BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA SYSTEM on behalf of LOUISIANA TECH UNIVERSITY, who respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an extension of time to file an opposition to Defendant's Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay Proceedings Pending Arbitration (Rec. Doc. 6) for the following reasons, to wit:

1.

Defendant, Conference USA, filed its Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay Proceedings Pending Arbitration on March 17, 2026. (Rec. Doc. 6).

2.

The parties met and conferred on March 20, 2026, regarding mediation of the pending claims.

3.

On March 26, 2026, the parties agreed to mediation and have currently have pending mediation on April 8, 2026.

4.

Plaintiff's opposition to Defendant's Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay Proceedings Pending Arbitration is currently due on April 8, 2026. (Rec. Doc. 7). The Defendant's reply briefing is due seven (7) days after the opposition is filed.

5.

Plaintiff's counsel conferred with Defendant's counsel March 30, 2026, regarding pending deadlines and motions before the Court. Counsel for Defendant's consented to, and does not oppose this motion for a continuance of the deadlines in Rec. Doc. 7, of two weeks or until April 22, 2026, for Plaintiff to file its opposition.

6.

The requested continuance of the deadlines is in good faith and not for purposes of delay, or prejudice to any party, as the parties attend mediation with effort to resolve the claims.

7.

Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7.2, "[a] memorandum is not required for...extension of a deadline."

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully prays that this Honorable Court grant this Uncontested Continuance of Deadlines established in Rec. Doc. 7 for briefing in opposition to and / or reply to Defendants Motion to Compel Arbitration and Stay of Proceedings Pending Arbitration.
